

THE HEBREW ALPHABET *script* with VOWELS

Use this sheet of the Hebrew alphabet to practice writing the letters in *script* form with the vowels. First, listen to your CD [Track 2], then pronounce each consonant with its vowel as you practice your script. Remember, to use the *script* form when writing your Hebrew letters. The *alef* is done for you.
